Funeral services will be held Saturday, Dec. 1 at 2 p.m. with visitation one hour prior at the church. On Saturday, Nov. 24, 2018, Geoffrey Lynn Sadler, loving husband and father of two children, passed away at the age of 48. Geoff was born Sept. 17, 1970 in Little Rock, Arkansas to Harold Lynn (Gwen) Sadler, of Cabot, Arkansas, and Millicent Imogene Reed (Boyd) Webb, of Germantown. Geoff attended Germantown High School and the University of Memphis. Geoff proudly served during Desert Storm as a submariner in the United States Navy. After serving his country, Geoff resumed his education, studying information systems. He pursued a career in computer network engineering with a specialty in security.
