Robert J. Lamere, 89, recently of Germantown, Tennessee and formerly of Venice, Florida and Manchester, New Hampshire, died Sunday, January 28, 2018. Born in Ludlow, Vermont on February 13, 1928, Bob was the son of Benjamin and Vera Lamere. After graduating from Black River High School in Ludlow he served in the Army Signal Corps. While stationed in El Paso Texas, he met and became engaged to Zaida P. Daniels. They were married in 1951 and moved to Manchester New Hampshire to raise their children (Jan, Jennie and Paul). There he worked as an electrical engineer at the RD Brew company. In 2003 he and Zaida retired to Venice Florida, until Zaida's death in 2016. In 2017, Bob moved to Germantown to live with his daughter Jan and her family.
