Charlotte “Nanny” F. Runnion, resident of Hot Springs Village AR, formerly of Memphis TN, passed away on December 3rd 2017 in her home, at the age of 98 years. She was born in Hartford KY on June 24th 1919 to Michael and Sally Federspiel. She married Harry L. Runnion and had two daughters Sherran Runnion and Harriett Runnion Crews. She retired from General Electric after 35 years. During her time there she was one of the founders and V.P. of the 474 IWEB Electrical Workers Union through which she fought for better wages, hours, and benefits for herself and her colleagues.
