## **Dr. Stanley Ladelle Anderson**

AUG 11, 2017

**D**r. Stanley Ladelle Anderson, 49 years of age, born in Memphis, Tennessee, transitioned to his everlasting life Friday, August 11, 2017 after a courageous battle with multiple myeloma cancer. Dr. Anderson was an humble man, who devoted his life to serving others as a dedicated OBGYN physician and one of the first Davinci robotic surgeons in the Kansas City region and for HCA Research Medical Hospital in Missouri. As the only Kansas City regional African American male OBGYN physician, he made history, paved the way for others, and his legacy will live on through the thousands of lives he delivered. In 2014, he simultaneously served as the Chairperson for the OBGYN Department at Research Medical Center Hospital, and served patients in two other busy office locations in Missouri including Swope Clinic. Dr. Anderson received his undergraduate and medical school training at Saint Louis University. He served numerous patients in St. Louis at Depaul and St. Mary's hospitals and completed his residency at St. Luke's hospital. Dr. Anderson was a national board certified physician, licensed in Virginia, Kansas and Missouri with awards in numerous areas. He was a member of many professional organizations including the American Medical Association, American College of OB/GYN FACOG and the Society of Laparoendoscopic surgeons. Lifting as he climbed, Dr. Anderson was a preceptor instructor of future doctors for Kansas City University of Medicine and Biosciences. Dr. Anderson was truly a family man who diligently focused his non-career time on his wife, Tiffany, who he met at Saint Louis University and their two children, Whitney and Christopher. Stanley and Tiffany were inseparable as they absolutely adored each other and spent every free moment together. Stanley transitioned to his next life on their 24th wedding anniversary weekend with Tiffany and family members by his side holding his hand as he entered his new life. Stanley had a special bond with both children as he helped to deliver them during his residency. He enjoyed spoiling them. Whitney completed her undergraduate studies

in 3 years from St. Louis University in 2016 as a Public Health and PreMed student; and celebrates her September birthdays on the same birthdate as her dad. She is a daddy's girl lovingly referenced as his "Tweetie" from the cartoon they watched when he cared for her as an infant. Stanley enjoyed playing sports with his son Chris, a Kansas University student. He referred to Chris as his #1 son as he proudly shared Chris' athletic accomplishments with others. They enjoyed catching a good Cardinals baseball game as one of their favorite activities. Dr. Anderson is survived by his devoted wife Dr. Tiffany Anderson, his children Whitney Kristine and Christopher Dale Anderson of Overland Park, KS; his mother, Gertrude Anderson; his mother-in-law, Edna Montgomery, his father-in-law, Larry (Jackie) Brown of St. Louis, MO; siblings, Calvin (Belinda) Anderson, Carolyn (Jeff) McFadgon, Barbara Mitchell, Edward (Barbara) Anderson and Carl Anderson all of Memphis, TN; and a host of uncles, aunts, nephews, nieces, cousins and numerous loving colleagues and friends. Dr. Anderson accepted Christ and was baptized at an early age. He was ushered into his new life with his wife holding his hand giving loving words of comfort and encouragement at 11:30 PM Friday August 11, 2017. The home-going celebration of Dr. Stanley Anderson's life will be held at Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church, 918 Looney Avenue, Memphis, TN, 38107 at 11:30 AM on Friday, August 18, 2017 with the visitation beginning at 10AM. A man who adored me and I adored him. We spent every moment outside of work together and on weekends. When he saw patients, I often sat in the parking lot and waited on him so we could begin our weekends together. When he had chemo, I called it our chemo and together we went every weekend and many weeknights for years. We were clearly a match made by God as he was a complete complement to every area in which I needed to be fulfilled, and I complemented him in just the right ways. God creates people for each other to uplift his work and, oh my, what a joyous privilege to have had the honor to be Stan's wife, uplifting the work of him bringing children into the world so that I could educate them. He brought them in and I took it from there, and together we improved the lives of children in multiple states. We had this work covered – from the womb to college. One doctor on one end and one on the other. What a team! I can remember praying as I transitioned in my second year of college, praying that God place those in my life he wanted me to have for his work to be done. Soon after, while lost on campus at Saint Louis University, I met Stan. He found me. I was lost on campus, and my future husband found me far from where I needed to be, on the opposite end of the campus, and directed me to where I was supposed to go. Even that now has another deeper prophetic meaning. It was love at first sight, literally. There was just something about him, and he said the same about me. After one date, we were inseparable, and we were married by the end of the year on August 14, 1993. As I began my career and supported him through medical school, he cared for our newborn daughter and took her to classes with him, resulting in her deep knowledge of science. She just graduated from SLU in public health pre-med and works in the ER at DePaul Hospital, the hospital where he worked as an OB-GYN resident. Her second job is at Children's Hospital, teaching public health classes in the community while she studies to take the medical school exam. My son Chris, who also has a gentle soul, learned so much on how to be a kind, humble, strong man from watching his father in action. His bond with his dad was amazing to watch – through everything, Stan never missed an athletic event for Chris, who played multiple sports. Supporting the children we were blessed to have is a lesson to be learned from watching such a great man. Because Stan encouraged me to become a school leader, I am now a superintendent, impacting thousands of children. Because I encouraged and supported him through medical school, he excelled to the highest possible levels of his career and delivered thousands of new lives.
