She was born on January 13, 1946 in Memphis, developed leadership skills at Camp Miramichee and was graduated from Kingsbury High School where she was a cheerleader and Miss Kingsbury. She attended Millsaps College where she was in Kappa Delta Sorority. Gail's career began at the City of Memphis where she rose quickly to the rank of Director of Insurance.
