Judith H. Adkins, 76, a long-time resident of Germantown, TN, died peacefully Monday the 5th of June after a courageous battle with cancer. Judy was surrounded by her loving family in one of her favorite places, Rosemary Beach, FL. Born December 19, 1940 in North Little Rock, AR she graduated high school in Corning, AR and continued her education at the University of MS where she met her devoted husband of 53 years, Lynn Adkins. While at Ole Miss, she attained a Business Administrative degree and was a member of Kappa Kappa Gamma sorority and remained an active Alumnae until her death. She was affectionately known as Juju and recognized by many for the beautiful smile she always wore, her inspiring spirit and her gift for encouraging others. Judy loved socializing with her friends and throughout her adult life she remained active in various charitable organizations including Josephine Circle, Twentieth Century Garden Club and Sassy Investors.
