## Angelo Joseph Ciaramitaro

MAY 15, 1931 - JAN 24, 2017

**A**ngelo Joseph Ciaramitaro, 85, resident of Ave Maria Assisted Living, Bartlett, TN, passed away January 24, 2017. Angelo was born in Memphis, TN on May 15, 1931 to Joseph and Julia Ciaramitaro.
