Dorothy Elizabeth Dyess Bryce Morton passed away on April 9, 2016. Dorothy was born in Waynesboro, Mississippi November 22, 1925 to William Reynolds Dyess, founder of Dyess, Arkansas, and Margaret Jackson Dyess Wade. She lived in Arkansas until moving to Memphis in 1940 and graduated from Hutchison School. She attended the William and Mary College, the University of Texas and Southwestern (Rhodes College).
