Roberta Brugge died on June 30, 2015. She was born in Pocahontas, Arkansas, on August 26, 1934, the daughter of Harry Williams and Virginia Black Williams. She graduated from Pocahontas High and attended Arkansas State. Roberta left college to marry and begin a family with her husband, Martin Brugge, in Memphis in 1954. They moved from Memphis to east Tennessee and lived in Farragut (then Concord) for 13 years where she was active in the Library, PTA and Vacation Bible School.
