Mrs. Sorrells was a graduate of Miss Hutchison School where she was a member of Tau Delta Sigma Sorority. She continued her education, attending Randolph Macon Women's College in Virginia where she was a member of Alpha Omicron Pi and was graduated in 1944 from School of Journalism at The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Mrs. Sorrells served on the Tennessee Federation of Republican Woman as recording secretary; served on the Shelby County Republican Primary Board and served as secretary of the Tennessee Republican Women's Club. She served on the board of directors of the Central Garden Area Association. In 1974, Mrs. Sorrells was appointed by Mayor Wyeth Chandler to the Shelby County Planning Commission. Mrs. Sorrells was an active volunteer and loved to play bridge. One area which she spent many enjoyable volunteer hours was at Idlewild Presbyterian. Mrs. Sorrells would rearrange Sunday services flowers for delivery to area hospitals.
