During her earlier years, she served on the staff at the American Embassy in Guatemala City, and then moved to the U.S. in 1956. Maria lived in Chicago for over 40 years as a loving, helpful, companion for DR. W.O. Fellman and his Marjorie, both preceding in her death. Dr. Fellman's granddaughters, Peg Fleming and Joanne Fleming, assisted Maria 15 years ago in relocating to Kirby Pines Estates in Memphis.
