## Yell Wah "Tommy" Low

JUN 20, 1932 - APR 13, 2015

Yell Wah “Mr. Tommy” Low, 82, died peacefully in his sleep early Monday morning, April 13, 2015. He leaves his wife, Annie, of 49 years; four children, Julie Chow, Suzanne Vail (Ben), Elizabeth Low, and Sunny Low (Shelby); and four grandchildren, Christopher Chow, Jonathan Chow, Spencer Low, and Savannah Low.
