Kate was an enthusiastic supporter of all her children, tirelessly chauffeuring them to school and social events, never missing a game involving sons Mark and Rob, who were active in football, baseball, and basketball in elementary school, and who went on to play professional baseball and college football. She was a fabulous cook, who welcomed to her table her children's and grandchildren's friends and anyone without a place to go for holiday meals. She also graced her wide circle of friends with gifts of her delicious treats, especially her famous pocketbook rolls, fantastic pies, and traditional Christmas coffee cake. Kate and her husband George were founding members of Holy Rosary Catholic Church, where she remained a member until her death. She was former president of Madonna Circle, active in Circle Arts, former president of the Holy Rosary Mothers Club, and a former member of Les Passees.
