A loving father and husband, Hill Howard Massengill, 75, of Germantown, Tenn., died April 9, 2014. Born in Covington, Tenn., on April 20, 1938, he attended Byars Hall High School and graduated from the University of Memphis. He was a member of Kappa Sigma and Emmanuel Methodist Church, served in the United State Marine Corp, and retired from First American Title. A quiet man, his love for his family ran deep, and his compassion and empathy for all was unending. He will be remembered fondly for his ability to fix anything—bikes, washers, leaks and cars.
