# Howard "Roy" Berkenstock

Howard R. "Roy" Berkenstock, Jr., of Memphis, TN, and Gulf Shores, AL, lost his battle with esophageal cancer on March 10, 2014. A memorial service celebrating Roy's life will be conducted by the Reverend Mark Frazier at 2:30 p.m. Friday, March 14 at Memorial Park Funeral Home, with military honors. The family will receive friends one hour prior to the service.
