Elizabeth "Betsy" Fay dePoincy passed away at Methodist Healthcare Hospice on March 1, 2014 at 11:16 a.m. at the age of 76. Betsy was born in Memphis, TN in 1937. She graduated from St. Agnes High School in 1955 and attended Hollins College in Roanoke, VA. She earned her Private Pilot License in 1994 when she was 57, and firmly believed that flying brought her closer to God. She enjoyed traveling around the world, especially eco-travel to such places as Africa, Antarctica and Central America, and visited the Galapagos Island four times. Her favorite way to travel was with her children and grandson.
