She was a graduate of Treadwell HS (Student Body President, class of '51, Top Rank Lt Col ROTC and cheerleader) and, later, she earned a BA (Communication & Fine Arts, class of '87) from the University of Memphis. She retired from First TN Bank & the National Bank of Commerce. Life-long lover of dance, Peggy had been a performer with the Memphis Open Air Theatre (MOAT) as an ongoing troupe member; and, later, was a volunteer at Theater Memphis.
