## **Patricia "Bronwein" Stevens**

**P**atricia "Bronwein" Stevens, 68, beloved mother, daughter, sister, aunt, and friend of Memphis, TN passed away peacefully on July 9, 2013. Bronwein was a graduate of Overton High School in 1961. She attended Memphis State University and was a member of Gamma Phi Beta Sorority. Bronwein later moved to Chicago, Illinois where she resided for 34 years. During Bronwein's stay in Chicago, she had a successful career in accounting. She participated in numerous volunteer activities, including leading both walking and river tours for the Chicago Architecture Foundation. Additionally, Bronwein supported Chicago's theatre community as a member of the Saints, interacted with guests as a docent at the Lincoln Park Zoo and taught science to students at the Museum of Science and Industry.
