Sally Wallace Hook, 93, died peacefully in her sleep Sunday morning. She leaves her sons Richard Gary West of Memphis and Fort Myers, Florida, and Frederick Wallace Smith of Memphis. Her middle son Vernon Thomas West preceded her in death in 1977. She is survived by 17 grandchildren, 18 great-grandchildren and four great-great-grandchildren, all of whom will dearly miss “Mimi” as she was widely known. Mrs. Hook, daughter of Thomas Arthur Wallace and Florence Love Wallace, was born in Jackson, Tennessee on September 6th, 1919.
