Harry B. “Skip” Sharp, age 73, passed away Saturday night, December 22, 2012. He leaves his wife, Glenda, mother-in-law, Dorothy Davis, and brother – and sister-in-law, Eddy and Deorenda Davis. Skip and Glenda were happily married for 31 years. He was preceded in death, at a young age of 34, by his first wife Evelyn Lewis. Skip was a lifelong Memphian but for six years spent in Knoxville at the University of Tennessee (UT) earning a BS in Accounting and a MBA in Industrial Management. A career with the Internal Revenue Service provided variety in his professional life as he held numerous staff and managerial positions, retiring after 32 satisfying years.
