Born on July 14, 1947, in Memphis, TN, Roy was a graduate of Central High School, Rhodes College, and the University of Tennessee Medical School. After completing medical school, Dr. Roy Kulp, Jr. trained in radiology at Methodist from 1976 through 1979 and was board certified. He was a loyal partner with Memphis Radiological Professional Corporation from 1979 until his retirement in 2005. Professional partners and everyone in the radiology department loved and admired him, as he was a true friend and brother. Roy's hard work, gentle leadership, and compassionate smile and demeanor softened many hard days for patients and coworkers. Dr. Kulp mentored many residents during their training, several of whom were fortunate enough to become his partners.
