DR. JERRY lynn shenep, 60, passed away peacefully at MD Anderson on July 26 with his family at his side after a valiant seven year battle with multiple myeloma and AML. He was born in Memphis, TN on October 7, 1951. Jerry attended Rhodes College and Vanderbilt School of Medicine. He was the Chief Medical Information Officer at St. Jude Children's Research Hospital and a Professor of Pediatrics at University of Tennessee Health Science Center. He was listed on the Best Doctors in America for Pediatric Infectious Diseases from 1998 – 2012. Jerry was a member of Faith Presbyterian Church. He is survived by his wife Mary Ann Shenep and his twin daughters Lori Elise Shenep and Melissa Anne Shenep.
