Ronald Wayne (Ronnie) Stevens, 67, of Memphis passed away on Thursday, June 9, 2011 after a long illness. Ronnie was a native Memphian born on October 9, 1943. He developed his love for music while playing the clarinet in the school band at Snowden Junior High School and Central High School. He went on to receive a Bachelor of Science Degree in Electrical Engineering at the University of Tennessee-Knoxville. After graduation Ronnie returned to Memphis to become President of Stevens Electric Co., Inc. a family owned business. He ran the business along with his two brothers, Frank W. Stevens, Jr. and Robert M. Stevens. Ronnie enjoyed spending time with his family and friends at his cabin at Pickwick. He will be remembered for his great sense of humor, his love for his family, his strong faith and his willingness to help anyone in need. Ronnie was a member of Germantown United Methodist Church.
