Mildred attended Meadow Central School and graduated from Lemmon High School in 1945 and graduated from Rapid City School of Business in 1946. She was a Legal Secretary in a law firm for five years in Rapid City SD. Mildred was married to J. Fred Voigt in 1950 and in 1951 she became a USAF wife and full time homemaker. In 1953 her husband, an Engineer, joined CB&I Co. and they made 13 moves in the West, Mid West, North West, and Mid South US before his retirement in Memphis in 1993. Mildred was a devoted full time homemaker which included being a 4-H club leader, a Cub Scout Den Mother, and school room mother activities.
