Marvin Virgil Neely, 63 of Olive Branch, MS formerly of Memphis, passed from this world to his heavenly home on October 8, 2009. He was born in Memphis, TN on October 6, 1946 the youngest of the eight children of Money V. Neely and Romalee Sanders Neely. He was a graduate of Westwood High School and Memphis State University. He was a decorated veteran of the Vietnam War where he served with the First Cavalry Division of the U.S. Army in 1967 and 1968. He was awarded the Bronze Star and Army Accommodation medals for his meritorious service and was honorably discharged in 1972. After a brief career at the I.C.R.R., Marvin spent 20 years in shopping center development and management with M.V. National Properties, The Edward J.
