Charles Edward Marcum, 84 of Independence, MS, formerly of Memphis, died in an auto accident Tuesday, May 5, 2009 in Senatobia, MS. Ed was a World War II veteran with the Headquarters Company 2d Battalion 182d Infantry where he received an honorable discharge from the Army on December 11, 1945. He retired from Memorial Park Funeral Home after 17 years where he received several certificates and awards for his dedicated service. He was the youngest of 13 children born to Richard & Iva Marcum, of which he was the last survivor.
