The family is concerned for the health and well-being of others, she will be interred at Memorial Park Cemetery w/ a private ceremony.




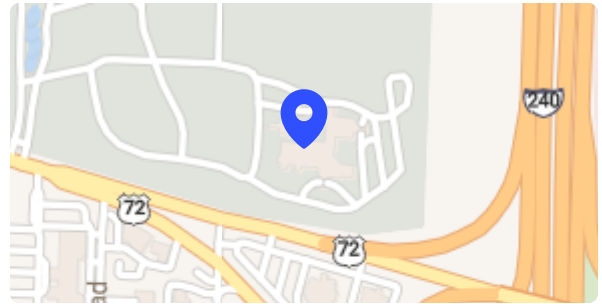
