Family will have private viewing and burial.




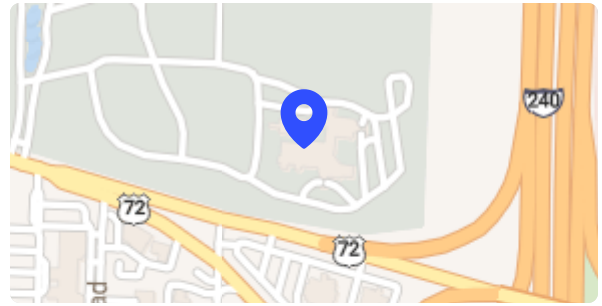
