In lieu of flowers, the family requests donations be made to either St. Jude Children's Research Hospital or Texas Children's Hospital in Houston, Texas.






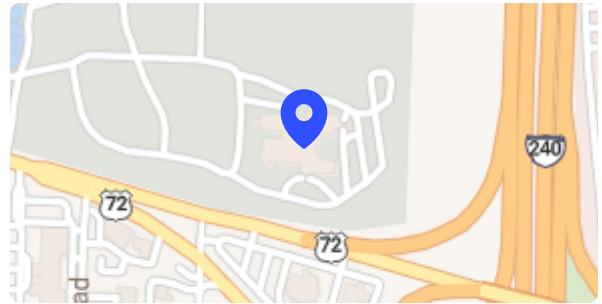

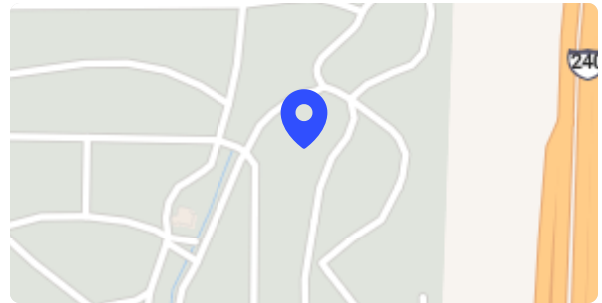
