Minnie L. Roosevelt, born Sept. 11, 1927, entering our Lord's Heaven on Aug. 22, 2021 at the age of 93. Minnie was pre-deceased by her husband Major Theodore Roosevelt, her parents Donnie and Ruby Hollis, her sisters Dona Elliott and Mary Williams, her niece Sarah Williams and great-nephew Eddie Roberts. Minnie lived a long and exciting life beginning in Memphis, TN. At 19 she married Air Force Navigator Theodore Roosevelt for 44 years. They traveled extensively to many countries. She was a volunteer with Red Cross and was a dental assistant to soldiers on the base. She volunteered with the Kings Daughters and Son's Home for 40 years and was a member of Memphis Cotton Carnival and was Queen of Shelbi in the mid 80's. An avid bowler in life, she won many awards. 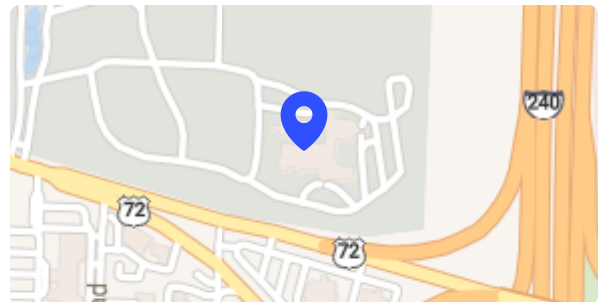

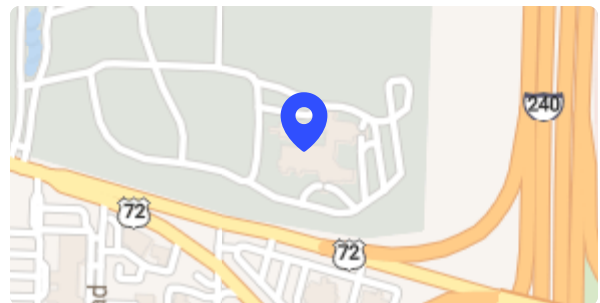
