Her time spent abroad heavily influenced her adult life and she shared her love of other cultures with her family. One of her favorite pastimes was to wander through her garden picking freshly ripened vegetables with her grandchildren in tow. She was also an artist who passed her love for all things creative to her children and grandchildren.
