Segui, Jr. (Mary) of Olive Branch, MS, Greg Segui (Carroll) of Byhalia, MS, and Michael Segui (Kathy) of Silverhill, AL, his brother, Philip Segui (Evelyn) of Charleston, SC, and his beloved grandchildren Hannah, Sammy, Josie, JohnPaul, Michaela, and Lucia.

Born in Fulton, KY to Felix and Maudell Segui, he grew up in Columbia, SC. Bill graduated from Eau Claire High School in 1956, where he formed life-long friendships and he and Angela met. He holds a B.S. in Civil Engineering, M.S., and Ph.D. from the University of South Carolina. After obtaining his B.S.C.E., he served as a commissioned officer in the U.S. Air Force from 1960-1963. In 1968, he joined the faculty at The University of Memphis where he retired as Professor Emeritus of Civil Engineering. He is the author of Steel Design, an engineering textbook in its 6th edition. He is a Life Member of the American Society of Civil Engineers.

If engineering and teaching hadn't worked out, he absolutely could have been a professional photographer. He had a clever sense of humor and his witty observations, delivered in all seriousness, regularly turned everyday situations into comedy gold.
