Visitation will occur at Memorial Park Funeral Home Poplar on Friday, February 11th at 10:00 with the funeral service to follow at 11:00.






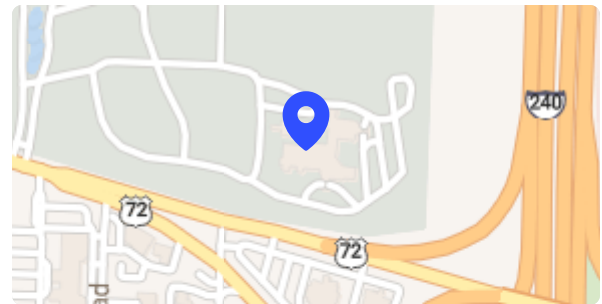

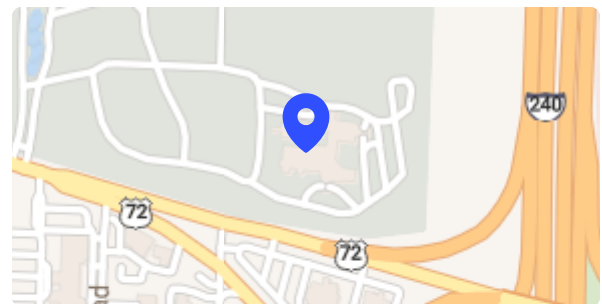

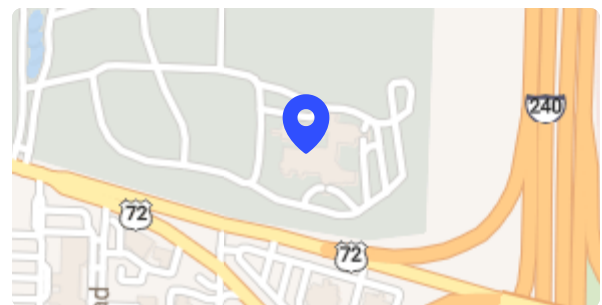
