Visitation will be Friday, April 29th starting at 1:00 p.m. until the service at 2:00 p.m.

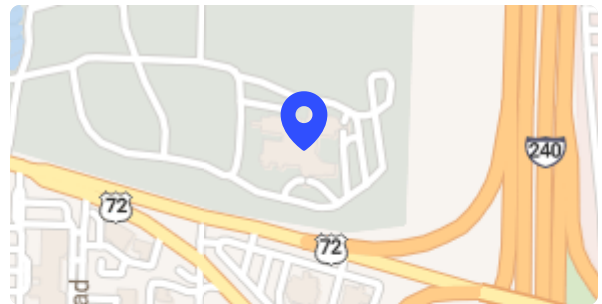

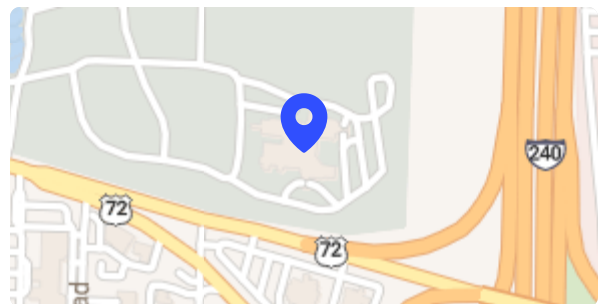

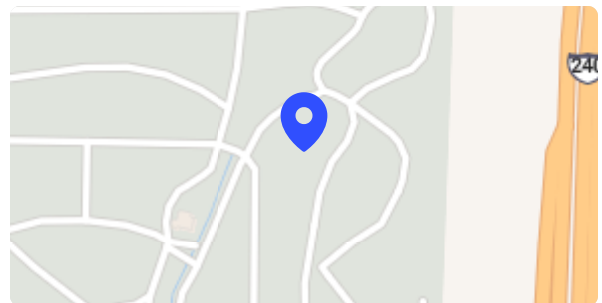
