## **Lou Ellen Anders**

JUN 21, 1918 - MAY 18, 2022

In lieu of flowers, donations may be made to Emmanuel United Methodist Church, Memphis Humane Society or a charity of the donor's choice.






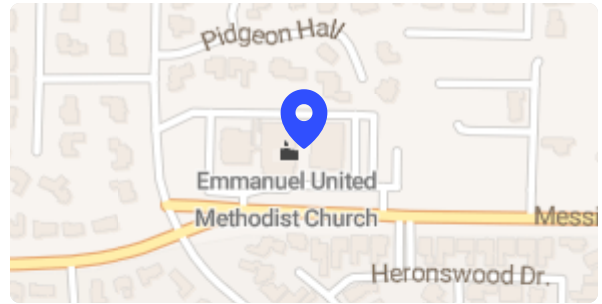

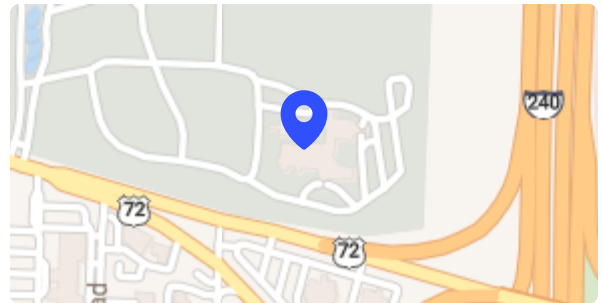
