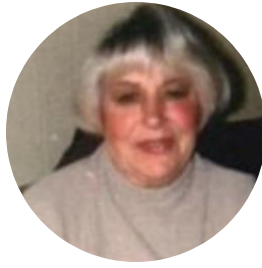

Dottie was born on May 27, 1930 in Memphis, TN, to John Murray Russell and Clara Mae Campbell Russell.

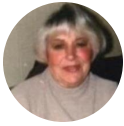
She retired from MLGW and attended Holy Rosary Catholic Church for many years.
