Patricia “Kay” Stewart Jones, 79, of Cordova, Tennessee, passed away peacefully on August 15, 2022, in Memphis.

In her spare time, she loved reading murder mystery novels, gardening, and watching professional golf on television, but her greatest joy was spending time with her sons and granddaughters.
