Interment will follow at Memorial Park Cemetery, 5668 Poplar Ave, Memphis, Tennessee 38119



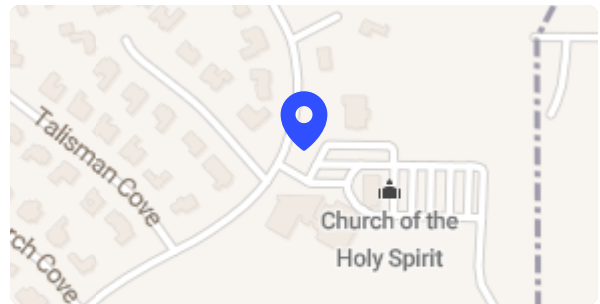

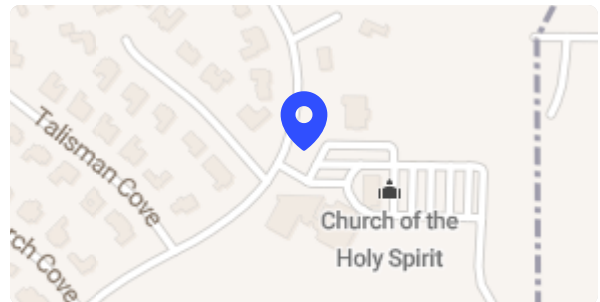

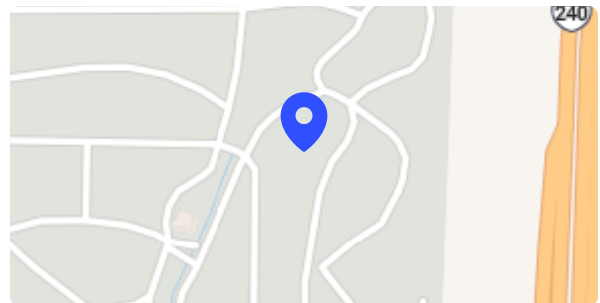
