Joe Arthur Burns, Sr. was born in Memphis, TN to Berry Ellis Burns and Susannah Burns. He passed away on December 16th, 2022. He was married to Rosemary Morrow for 62 years with four children: Joe, Jr., Mary Kathleen, Bryan Lee 1964-2018 and James Christopher 1974-2007. Life long member of Church of Christ, member at Germantown for 37 years.

He graduated from Treadwell High School in Memphis, TN in 1959. He went on to attend Memphis State University 1964-1968 where he graduated with a Bachelor of Science degree. He started his career in medical sales for Roche Labs from 1970- 1985. National Contract Manager for Konica Minolta Medical, negotiating national Contracts for corporate hospital and medical companies from 1985 until retirement on 8 August 2008.

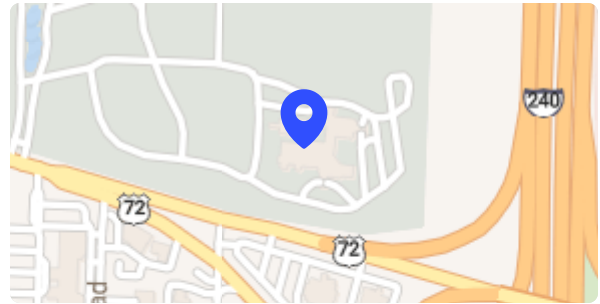

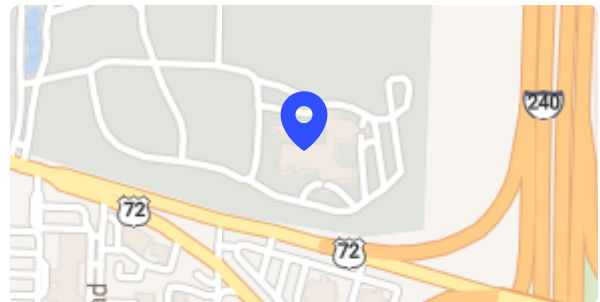

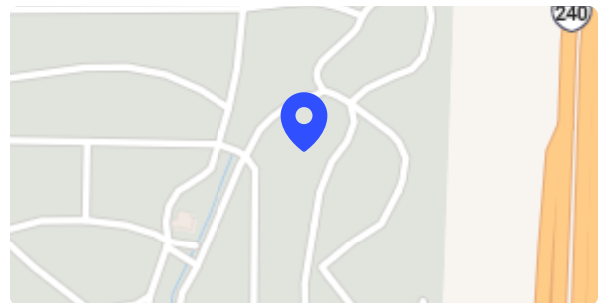
