David will be laid to rest at Memphis Memorial Park Cemetery alongside his parents.




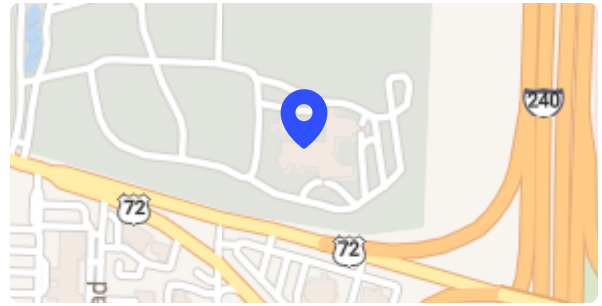
