The family would like to extend their heartfelt gratitude to the staff at Bright Glade Nursing Home for their exceptional care, kindness and compassion during her time there.



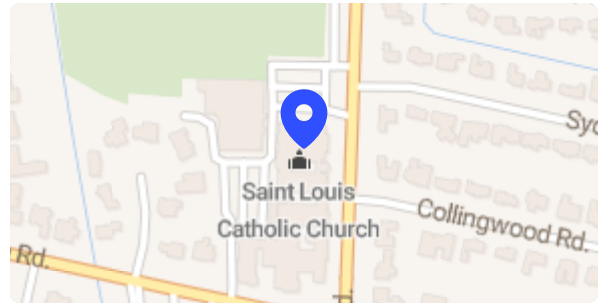

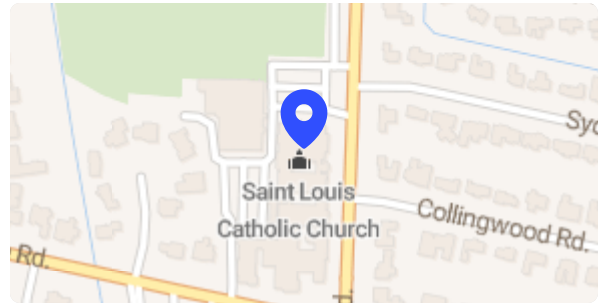
