Ronald Stephen "Steve" Chandler, Sr., age 71, of Memphis, Tennessee passed away at home on June 24, 2024. Steve was born February 1, 1953, in Dyer County, Tennessee to Betty Simpson Armstrong Chandler and Bob Armstrong. He graduated from Treadwell High School in Memphis, TN. He worked for Jamison Pest Control, was a veteran Reservist of the Shelby County Sheriff's Department, and owner of AtLast Pest Management Inc. He was a member of the West Tennessee Pest Control Association.

His many hobbies included gardening, fishing, visiting the beach, reading, hosting Bible Studies, and spending time with his family. 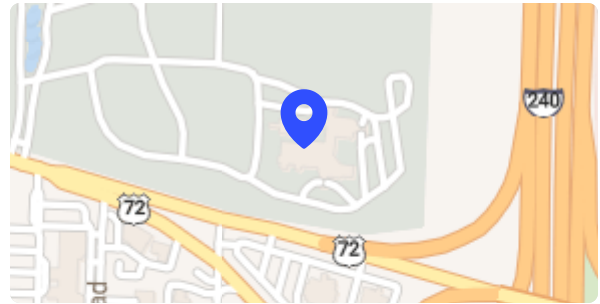

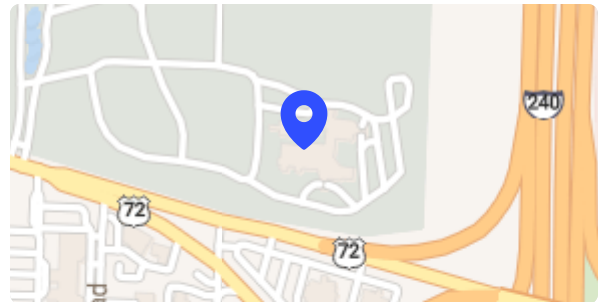

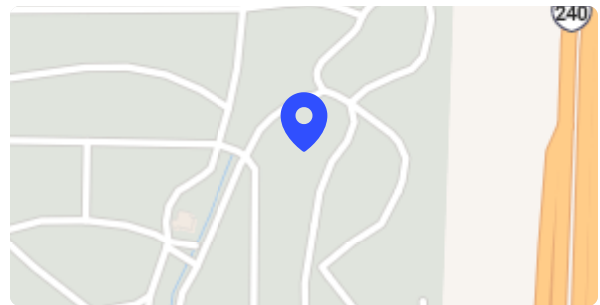
