Born July 6, 1942, to Paul and Mary Louise Neal of Houston, MS, Nina will be remembered for her unwavering faith in God, her devotion to her family, her strength of spirit, and her infectious laugh.

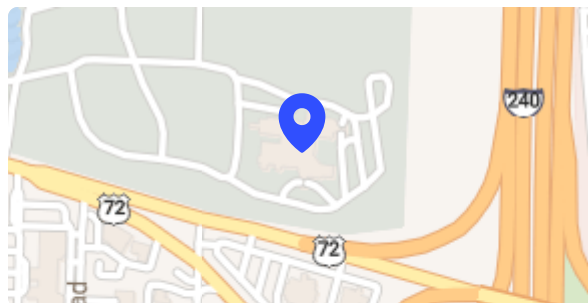

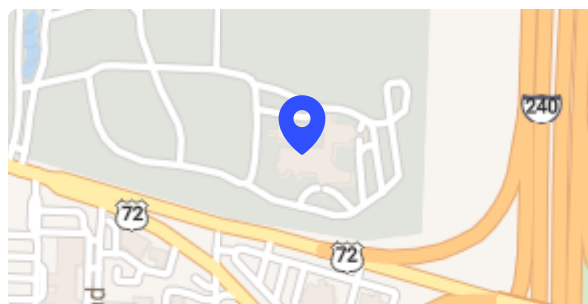
