Upon graduation, he began a 32-year career with International Paper Company, starting at their Mobile Mill where he rose to the role of Paper Mill Superintendent. In 1990 he transferred to the company's Ticonderoga, New York Mill, and in 1992, he transferred to the headquarters location in Memphis, Tennessee. 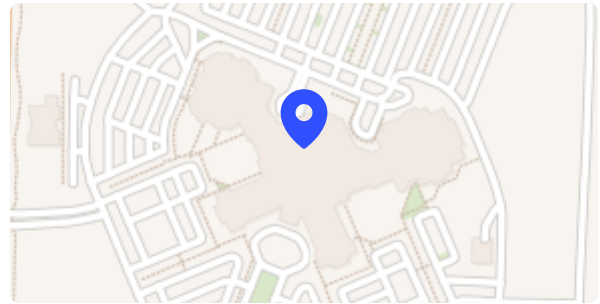

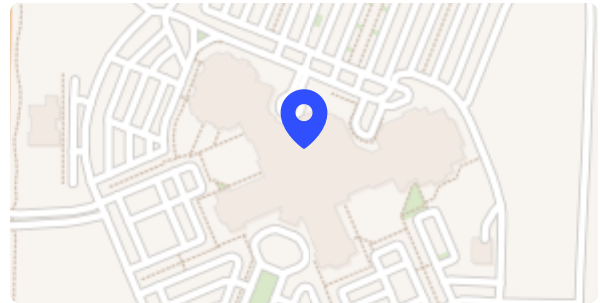

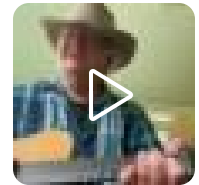
