Jane Barnard Dulin, 84, passed away peacefully on August 10, 2025, in Birmingham, Alabama. Born on April 25, 1941, in Chester, Illinois, Jane lived a life marked by grace, warmth, and an unwavering devotion to her family and community.

A graduate of Kingsbury High School in Memphis, Tennessee, Jane was an accomplished student and athlete. She served as the captain of the cheerleading squad. Jane's education continued at University of Tennessee Dental School, where she completed the Dental Hygienist program and subsequently worked as a hygienist for several years.

Jane carried her love of sports into adulthood as an avid tennis player, picking up golf later in life. Although a quiet competitor, sports were a way to spend time with friends, and most importantly, on the golf course "walking nine" with her beloved husband and best friend, Phil. She always said, "If you can't beat em, join em!" but she always held her own.

Jane's life was deeply enriched by her 63-year marriage to John "Phil" Dulin. Known affectionately as "Janie" to Phil, she was his steadfast partner and best friend. Phil's career in banking became a big part of their life early in the Memphis community and beyond with travel around the world. A move to Chattanooga with two children in tow, then back to Memphis two years later, showed Jane's ability to do whatever was needed in support of her dear family. 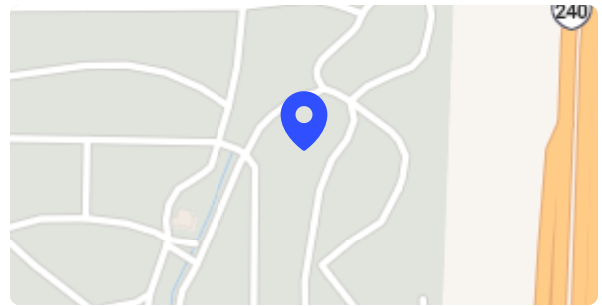

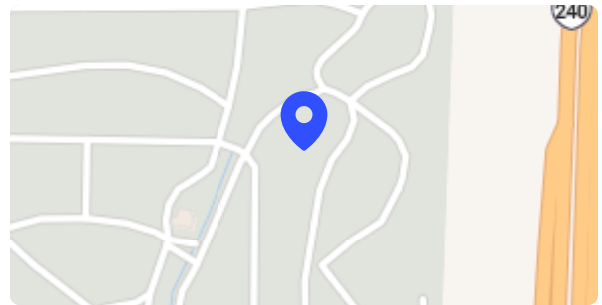

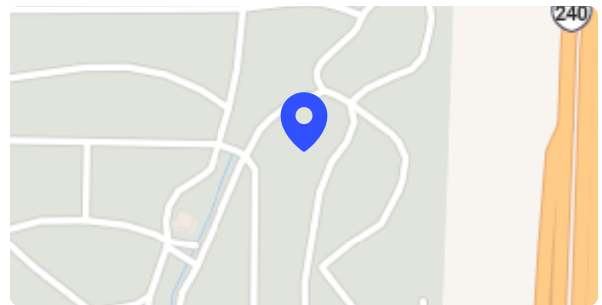
