She graduated from Sacred Heart School and was a CBC (now CBHS) cheerleader. She attended Memphis State. She spent her career as the Administrative Assistant for the ROTC division of the Memphis City Schools. She retired after 33 years.

Sue loved life. She was very involved in all her grandson's activities. She rarely missed any of them.

Sue loved to travel. She took many trips throughout the US, Europe, Asia, Australia and New Zealand. At various time travelling with her mother, son, grandson and daughter-in-law. She always wanted to explore a new itinerary.
