Freddie Joe Clark, of Collierville, Tennessee, passed away on February 18, 2026, after a courageous battle with Alzheimer's disease.

Joe was born on November 13, 1935, in Jonesboro, Arkansas, to the late James Clark and Imogene Powell Clark.

He is survived by his loving wife of 36 years, Margaret Martin Clark; his children Steve Clark (Terry) and Lisa Clark Sims (Barry); his brother-in-law David Martin; sisters-in-law Paulette Littlefield Clark and Karen Martin; and his longtime associate Jacqueline Thomas. He is also survived by his grandchildren: Michael Clark, Jeremiah Clark, and Annastasia Potts, along with a host of nieces and nephews.

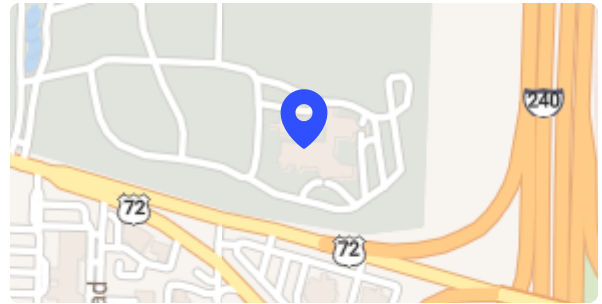

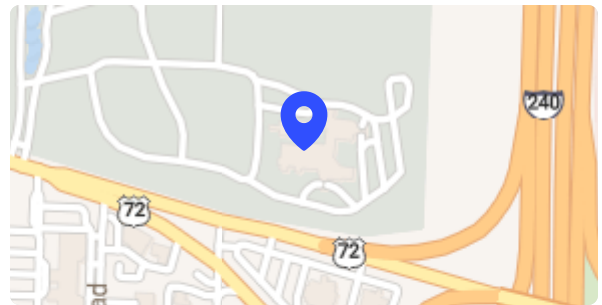
