



George Edwin Relyea

George Edwin Relyea passed away at the age of 67 on Friday, January 28, 2022 at his home in Memphis, TN.

He was born April 27, 1954 in Augsburg, Germany.

George was an Associate Professor in the division of Epidemiology, Biostatistics, and Environmental Health in the School of Public Health at the University of Memphis. He received his MA in Economics in 1981 and MS in Applied Mathematics in 1982 both from the University of Memphis. He collaborated extensively with faculty and students across the university on diverse research projects. He has developed many applied statistics courses including advanced statistical modeling. He has over 200 academic publications and has been a mentor for many graduate students. Highly regarded by students and faculty alike, he served on dissertation committees and represented the School of Public Health in the University Faculty Senate.

George will be cremated, and the ashes will rest at home. A Memorial gathering and Celebration of Life will be held on April 16, 2022 at the home of his sister and brother-in-law Mary and Hani Rashed.
